BRAYDEN BISHOFF SCHOLARSHIP

The Preston County Livestock Association (PCLA) encourages its current active members, who are seniors and will be graduating in the spring of 2023 to apply for the Brayden Bishoff Scholarship. Brayden passed away in 2019 as the result of a car accident. When he passed away, he was 15 years old and a sophomore at Preston High School pursuing CTE completion in the electrical and agriculture programs. Brayden was a member of the association, the FFA, and a member of the Lenox Loyal Workers 4-H Club. He loved showing animals- particularly beef or sheep and he planned to include his love for agriculture in the future. The membership chose to rename the PCLA scholarship in his memory.

Scholarship Criteria:

- A current active junior member of the PCLA, who meets all criteria and rules for the 2022-2023 membership year. Junior members must remain in good standing and have completed a market project by showing and selling it at the 2023 PCLA Youth Market Show and Sale.
- Current 4H and/or FFA member in good standing.
- Graduating senior in the spring of 2023.
- Submission of scholarship information and discussion questions to the PCLA Board of Directors, on or before April 26, 2023.
 - Please note, applications must be in our possession on April 26, 2023, to review them before the May general membership meeting.
- Scholarships will be awarded in May 2023. Funding of the scholarship awards is contingent upon the successful completion of the first semester of college or trade school. Awardees are required to submit proof of a successful first semester completion from the enrolled institution.
- Checks will be made payable to the institution on behalf of the awardee. If the junior member is receiving a full scholarship or tuition to a college or trade school, the scholarship can be redirected to help cover additional related expenses up to the amount of the scholarship.
- This scholarship being awarded is contingent upon funds availability and is at the discretion of the PCLA Board or Directors.
