RULES

 - Lamb, Goat & Steer junior members that attend – 30 points
 - Lamb junior members that show - 20 points
 - Hog, Goat & Steer junior members that attend – 30 points
 - Goat junior members that show - 20 points
 - Lamb, Hog & Steer junior members that attend – 30 points
 - Barn clean-up for small animal preview shows - 20 points
 - Appalachian Youth Livestock Showcase
 - All junior members that show - 30 points
 - Junior members that do not show but attend - 20 points
 - Volunteer to set-up for AYLS - 20 points
 - Volunteer to clean-up for AYLS - 20 points
 - Letter Writing Clinic – 20 points
 - Optional Weight Check - 10 points
 - Barn Setup for BWF - 10 points
 - October 5th Meeting - 20 points
 - Exhibit any species at the State Fair of WV - 5 points
 - Participation in any additional PCLA fundraising opportunity - 20 points
 - Volunteering for any additional PCLA activities - 20 points
 - Submit a letter to be considered for a PCLA Junior Board Member – 10 points
